

The 4th Congress of Scandinavian Slavists

The 4th Congress of the Association of Scandinavian Slavists and Baltologists was held at Hindsgavl Castle, Denmark, from 23rd–29th August, 1964. Hosts and organisers on this occasion were the Slavists of Copenhagen, headed by Prof. Carl Stief. The congress was opened by a memorial address in honour of the late Prof. Adolf Stender-Petersen, Århus, by Prof. Gunnar Gunnarsson, Uppsala, followed by an address in memory of the late Prof. Eino Nieminen, Helsinki, by Prof. Christian S. Stang, Oslo.
