For all of you who consider becoming a member of a **trade union**, a **comprehensive list** and information regarding trade unions associated to UiO can be found here. To clarify the **benefits and differences** between the **unions** that exist, we are planning an **event later in Spring** where representatives of each will present themselves and answer questions.

One of the **benefits of union membership**, is that you can submit an **individual claim for promotion** - which we **encourage all PhD students who were duped by the PhD wage gap** to do on grounds of the higher salary level of newly employed PhD students after May 1st 2019. The next opportunity to do this will be for the annual 2.5.1 negotiations after Summer (deadline: August). However you can already submit a claim **this week** for the so-called 2.5.3 salary negotiations in February, based on an extraordinary work effort or change in work circumstances. Please refer to your union (or become a member if you aren't vet!) for more information.

If you are eager to know more about what unions are doing about the wage gap, you can attend an **information session** with **Forskerforbundet** hosted by the **IBV Grad Forum** on **January 28th**. In the meantime, negotiations with Departmental and University administration about the wage gap are continuing, and we will keep you posted with updates.
